EMMA'S TOP TIPS

Keep the ball in play until you are ready to go on the offensive. Get the racket back and move your feet so that you are in your comfort zone for hitting the ball at the optimal height you like to make contact. Your objective is to get in the right position to allow this to happen. Keep the feet going, stay on your toes & react to the shot coming at you to get into that optimal striking position. Get the racket back early, get good net clearance to strike deep into your opponent's court which should then create the opportunities to go on the offensive.
